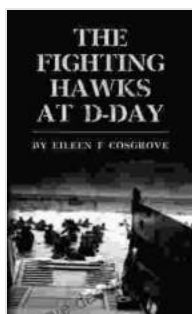


The Fighting Hawks At D Day (The Fighting Hawks 1)

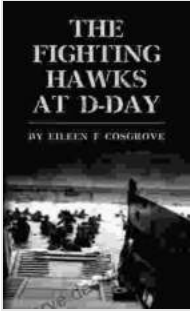

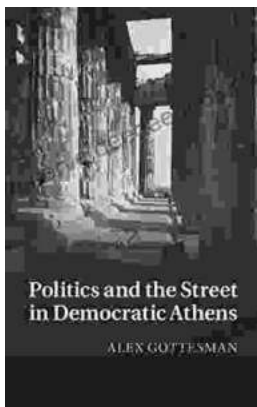
