
The Hero of Paris Valley



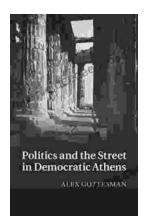
