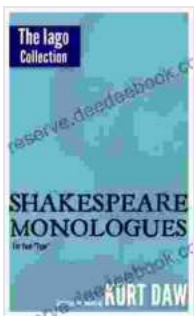

- "We are such stuff as dreams are made on" from The Tempest

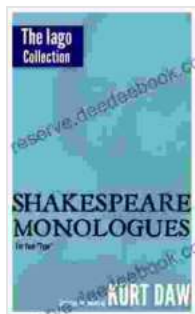
How to Choose the Right Monologue

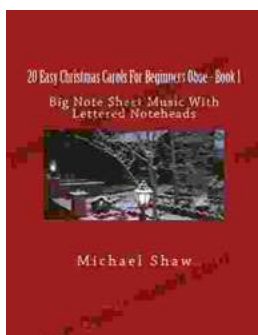

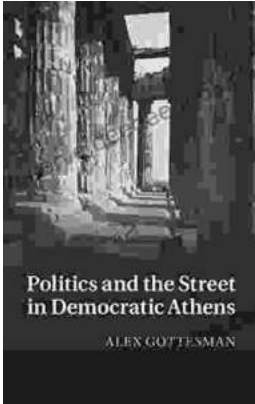
